REAL SIMPLE WEDDING VIDEO

Wages Video has been specializing in wedding videography since 1999.

One basic video is a long-form **Documentary** which combines natural sound and slower-paced editing with artistic title sequences. This video includes the complete ceremony and all of the events from the reception. We present it as a full length movie including an opening and closing title sequence.

You have the option of adding a shorter **Highlights** section to the Documentary. This section is a shorter, more artistic account of the day incorporating music and tasteful effects such as black and white. This is a ten to twenty minute long music video style video that is great for sharing with friends.

A short **Trailer** is also included in every package. It will be available online one to two weeks before your completed DVDs. You are welcome to share the video with your friends as it will be hosted on our website indefinitely. It will also be included on your DVD as a bonus feature.

How do I book my wedding date?

Before booking your wedding date, please contact me to make sure your date is available. I am constantly booking dates and my availability can change quickly.

After building or choosing a package, you will need to sign an agreement and return it to Wages Video, with your first retainer payment of one-third of the total package price.

Please contact Wages Video for an agreement. We will be happy to send you one via mail, e-mail or fax.

Will you be obtrusive on the wedding day?

No. I take great pride in remaining non-obtrusive on the wedding day. I prefer a more natural style where guests are less aware of the camera. To me, this means working with available light whenever possible and using a small on-camera light only when absolutely necessary. I usually use no extra light at all and *never* do guest interviews unless specifically approached by a guest.

How long will it take to finish our videos?

Usually one to two months after the wedding.

Will you attend the rehearsal to plan camera placement?

Yes, at my discretion. I'm familiar enough with many locations around Atlanta that it is often not necessary to come to the rehearsal. If I am unfamiliar with the location, or your ceremony requires special planning, I will usually come to the rehearsal. I don't charge any extra for my attendance.

Can our photomontage be prepared in advance to show at our rehearsal or reception?

Yes. We can supply a DVD for you in advance. Please get the photos to us at least two weeks before you will the montage.

Projection rental is available from Wages Video for a small fee.

Will you cover our rehearsal dinner toasts?

Yes. While I don't shoot the dinner itself, the toasts are often a wonderful addition to your video. They will typically be added to your wedding DVD as a bonus feature

accessible from the main menu. I charge \$90.00 an hour for my attendance.

Do you use wireless microphones?

Yes, I will usually use several wireless microphones for the ceremony. One of these usually goes on the groom's lapel. This is very important to capture the vows clearly.

Do you charge a travel fee?

I will travel up to an hour outside of metro Atlanta without charging a travel fee. If your wedding location is more than an hour outside of metro Atlanta, please contact Wages Video.

Can you shoot in low-light situations?

My cameras are very sensitive in low-light situations and it is usually not necessary to use any on-camera light. I rarely need to use any additional light and use a small on-camera light only when absolutely necessary.

Will you interview guests at the reception?

No. I've decided that these interviews don't suit my shooting style and usually make guests uncomfortable. I will, however, do on-the-spot interviews if a guest approaches me.

Can you provide references?

Yes, upon request.

Do you accept credit card payments?

Yes. We also accept payment via checks and PayPal.

Can we request music for our video?

Yes, I welcome any feedback you have.

Do you charge sales tax?

Yes, I am required to charge a sales tax of 7%.

Are you insured?

Yes, I am fully licensed and insured.

Additional Coverage (\$90/hour)

Begins at \$90.00 an hour.
Perfect for rehearsal dinner toasts.

Photomontage (\$300.00)

Contains up to 80 photos.
Can be prepared in advance to show at your rehearsal dinner.

Cinema Package (\$250.00)

Includes projector, screen, PA system and microphone.

Perfect for showing photomontage or slide show at rehearsal dinner.

Additional DVD Copies (\$30.00 each)

In engraved aluminum case.

Payments are in thirds. There is a retainer of one-third of the total package price required to reserve your wedding date. An additional one-third is due two weeks prior to your wedding date. The final payment of one-third is due upon delivery of the completed videos. This is usually one to two months after the wedding.
